UNIVERSITY OF ALBERTA UDATE FOR THE THE MALMO PLAINS COMMUNITY

Edmonton Police Services (EPS) is conducting police training on the MP site weekly. Prior to any training taking place EPS members will sweep the site.

U of A Protective Services (UAPS) patrols the MP site daily. We ask neighbours to please continue to call the EPS with general complaints at 780-423-4567 and emergency situations at 911. We would also ask that neighbours continue to call University of Alberta Protective Services at 780-492-5050 regarding any suspicious activities that you may see.

The U of A is currently considering demolishing a portion of the

MP. More information about plans for removal of buildings will be shared in these monthly updates.

The U of A will be repairing the broken fencing.

A question about air quality during demolition has come up. The U of A will fully abate each unit prior to demolition and a third party air monitoring consulting company will conduct air monitoring.

Abundant Community Edmonton (ACE) is an innovative City initiative that supports neighbours "to organize [their] neighbourhood around the strengths and potential of the people who live there to take action and achieve shared community goals."
