### Updated COVID-19 guidance from the City of Edmonton

With some aspects of COVID-19 changing, the City has relaxed some restrictions on gatherings. Reminders:

- Keep your guest list to no more than 50 people for outdoor gatherings. Be sure to remain 2 metres apart, and especially cautious when there are people not from the same household at the same gathering.
- Bring your own food and utensils, don't share food, and choose activities that can support social distancing guidelines.
- Have disinfectants close by to regularly clean commonly touched surfaces (e.g., armrests, gate latches, and patio railings).

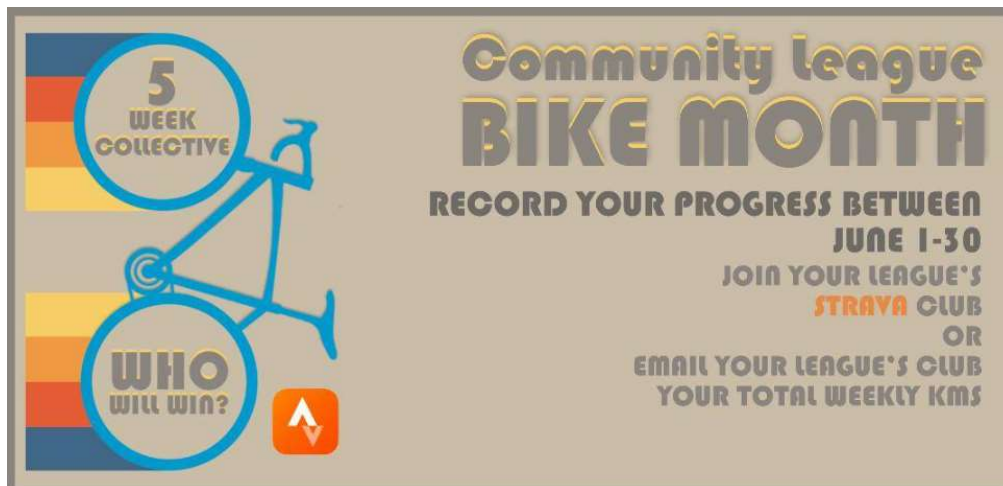
## June is Community League Bike Month!
