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
FACELIFT FOR OUR HALL!

MALMO COMMUNITY LEAGUE BUDGET



Budgets are integral to any organization, especially a nonprofit like a community league. Currently Malmo is in a strong financial position, and our goal is to continue building upon our resources.

Our key sources of income are grants, casino fundraising, and interest income. We have two accounts- general and casino. The casino account can only be used for AGLC (Alberta Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis) approved expenses (e.g., hall maintenance, newsletter, and rink). The general account funds our social events and sports programs.

Current numbers (as of August 18, 2023)

General: \$70,964.79 Casino: \$70,707.57 GIC: \$200,000 (4.55% maturity date Jan 6, 2025) \$100,000 (5.1% maturity date Aug 18, 2024)

Net assets: \$441,672.36
